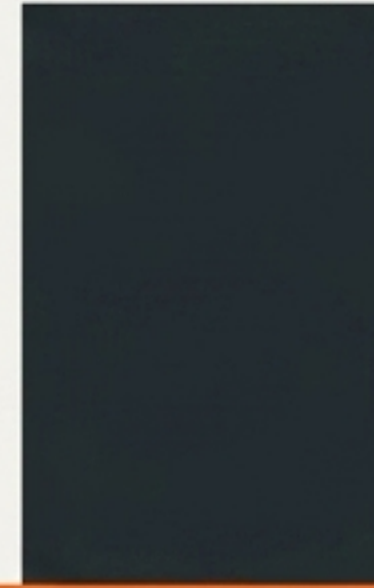
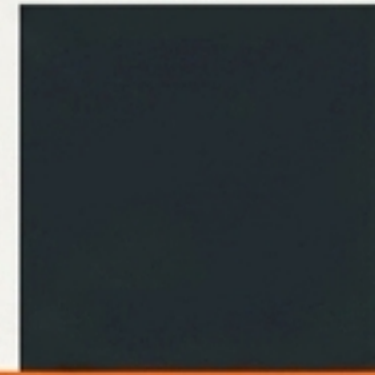
The Standard

Under the radar.

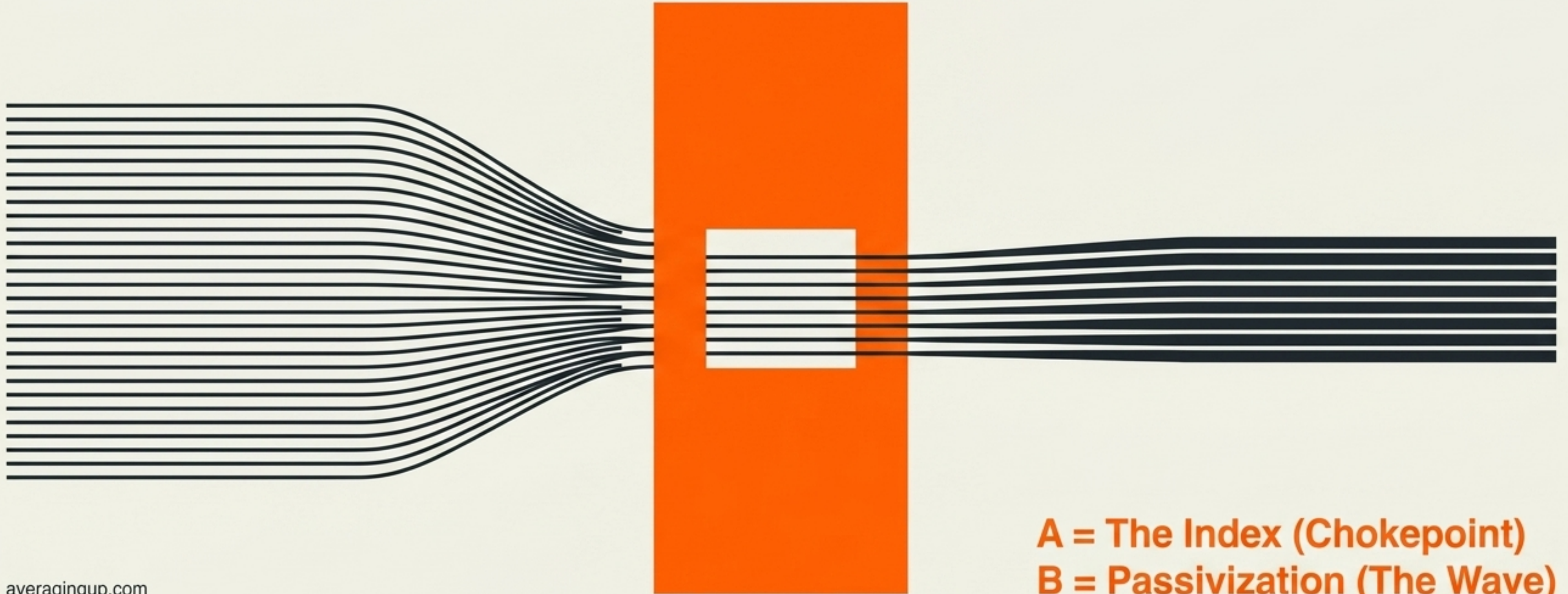
MSCI defines how institutional

B_1 : Passivization

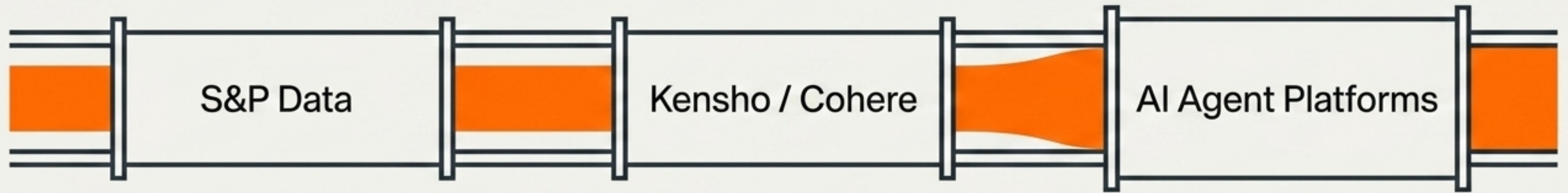
B_2 : AI Automation

Coupling through distribution.

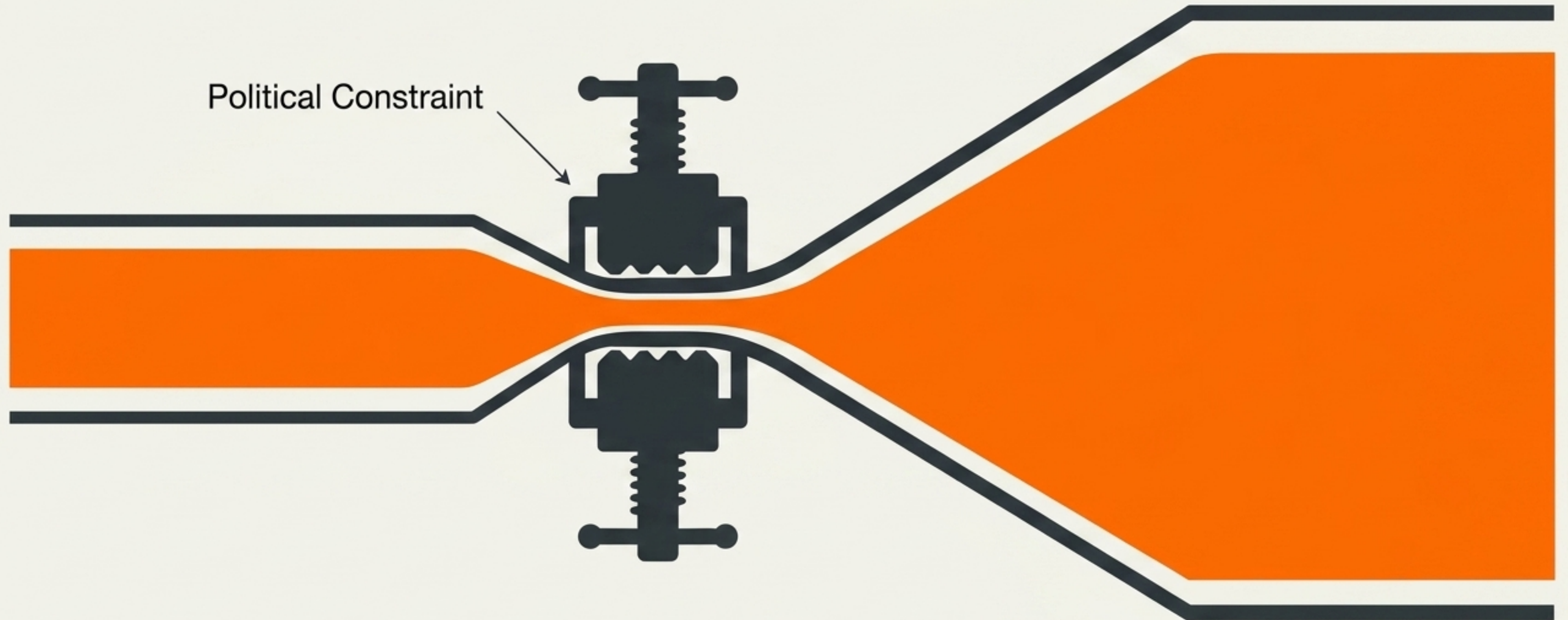


Data is consumed programmatically.

per unit.

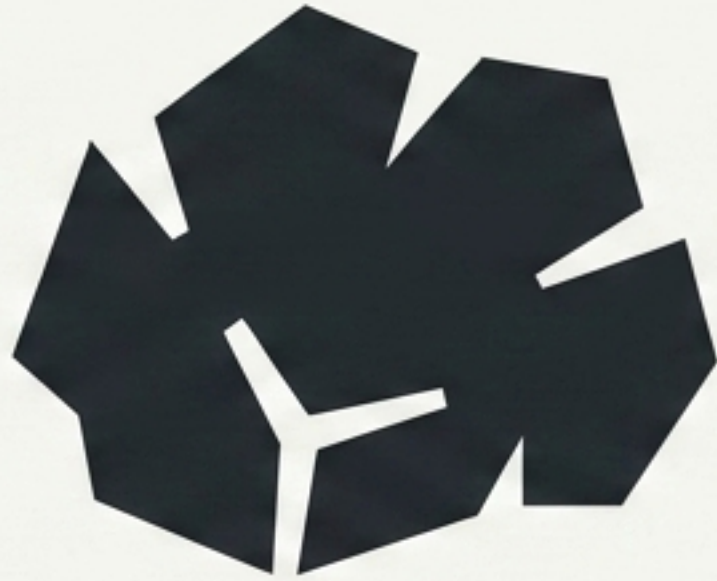
The secular wave
